Mathematics	4				
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**REQUIRED:** Algebra I; Algebra II; Geometry. The following are acceptable to fulfill remaining requirements: Statistics; Precalculus; Calculus; AP Statistics; AP Calculus; or a fourth math from VPE approved list. Algebra I taken in 8th grade does not count for High School credit

Science	4				
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**REQUIRED:** (1) Biology; (2) Physical Science taken in 8th grade OR Physics; (3) Chemistry OR Earth Systems OR Environmental Science OR AP; (4) Any science from VPE approved list.

Social Studies	3				
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**REQUIRED:** US History (or AP); World History (or AP); American Gov/Civics (or AP) AND Econ (or AP) - .5 credits each. A fourth Social Studies course from VPE approved list will count as an elective.

Foreign Language <u>OR</u> American Sign Language <u>OR</u> Computer Science	2				
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**REQUIRED:** Two years of the same foreign language or American Sign Language or Computer Science

Fine Arts (Band, Dance, Photography, etc), OR CTAE, OR 3rd year of foreign language	1				
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Health <u>AND</u> Physical Education	1

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<p><b>GENERAL NOTES:</b> Colleges like to see <b>math</b> in each of the 4 years prior to college entrance as well as an average of <b>FIVE AP</b> courses. SAT scores are good for FIVE years from the date of administration. The SAT is offered in Jan, Mar, May, June, Oct, Nov and Dec. The ACT is offered in Feb, Apr, June, Sept, Oct and Dec. Advanced Placement Exams are <b>ONLY</b> offered in May. Grade 11 is the most rigorous year. Colleges base admissions decisions on work in grades 9, 10 and 11.
